Cherilyn Rowland Petrie completed her Masters in Clinical Psychology at the University of Central Florida in 2001 and was licensed as a Mental Health Counselor in 2004. She is currently the Clinical Supervisor for the Mental Health Program at Kids House, the Children's Advocacy Center in Seminole County. She specializes in using EMDR Therapy to treat children who have experienced early trauma, attachment injury, and neglect who have complex clinical presentations. She was trained by the International Society for the Study of Trauma and Dissociation to treat of Dissociative Disorders in adults and in children. She was credentialed as an Approved Consultant in EMDR Therapy in 2013 through the EMDR International Association and volunteers training other professionals through the Trauma Recovery, EMDR Humanitarian Assistance Programs. She is also the Greater Orlando Trauma Recovery Network Coordinator and has led the EMDR community response to the Pulse tragedy in 2016.
